2. **What shared goal or dream do you think members of this culture are united by?**
3. **How connected do you feel to this culture's overall vision?**  
*(Scale: 1 - Not at all, 5 - Very connected)*

## Section 2: Common Values

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1. **What are the most important values or principles upheld by this culture?**
2. **What values do you often hear discussed or see practiced by members?**
3. **How would you describe the role of these values in daily life within this culture?**

### Section 3: Common Vocabulary

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1. **What words, phrases, or symbols are commonly used by members of this culture?**
2. **How important is it for members to understand and use these terms?**  
*(Scale: 1 - Not important, 5 - Very important)*
3. **What does this shared language add to the culture?**

### Section 4: Common Vulnerabilities

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1. **What challenges or weaknesses do you believe are common within this culture?**
2. **How openly do members discuss these challenges?**  
*(Scale: 1 - Not openly, 5 - Very openly)*
3. **How would you describe this culture's approach to addressing its vulnerabilities?**

### Section 5: Reflection

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1. **If you could tap into one aspect of this culture, what would it be, and why?**
2. **What do you most appreciate about becoming part of this culture?**

### Interpretation

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Recurring themes indicate shared aspects of vision, values, vocabulary, and vulnerabilities, revealing the deeper culture.
